## Rules and Regulations:

1. All drivers MUST wear a DOT approved helmet
2. NO alcoholic beverages of any kind on the grounds
3. NO riders anywhere on the fairgrounds – STAY IN MARKED AREA
4. NO unnecessary driving on the grounds
5. Each driver must be at least 16 years of age
6. Both hands must be kept on the handlebars at all times
7. Driver MUST stay seated on the seat
8. Each ATV can pull one time only
9. Vehicles must stay within marked boundary
10. NO one on the track except track officials and one puller
11. NO jerking, hot rodding of ATV in pit or track area
12. Judges have the right to stop and disqualify any ATV if it is being operated in an unsafe manner
13. Drivers must be with their ATV and in line while their class is being pulled
14. Arguing or unsportsmanlike conduct toward officials is cause for disqualification of BOTH ATV and driver for the day
15. Stock equipment only will be permitted
16. Cargo boxes can be on ATV but must be empty
17. NO modifications of chassis except for tire size
18. NO duals or chains
19. NO fluids in tires
20. NO fuel other than regular pump gas – no alcohol or racing fuel
21. Stock hitch must be used
22. Hitch height can be no higher than the rear axle
23. Hitch must be stationary in all directions
24. A one inch clevis must be used when making a pull
25. NO additional weights will be permitted
26. There will be no need to weight All Terrain Vehicles
27. Judges will inspect all ATV's and determine if ATV's are safe, and will check modifications that are illegal
28. Judges will decide what class ATV will pull in
29. When vehicle stops, the pull is complete
30. If there is a protest, the pulling officials will decide if it is a legitimate complaint (Example: engine modifications). If the judges decide that the complaint is legitimate, the protested ATV will be disqualified
31. All decisions by officials are FINAL
32. Judges have the option to re-pull all first pullers
33. In the event of a full pull, park near the end of the track and stay with your ATV until the class is finished. This is in case of a pull-off
